
SKEDADDLE'S PROBLEM: FIELD WORKER SAFETY PLAN

For Skedaddle, the safety of its employees has always been a top priority. "Our team members work alone going to people's homes – sometimes when there is no one around," says Bill Dowd, CEO of Skedaddle. "When we realized that there was a new technology out there to help monitor the safety of our team members, we knew that we had to check it out."

Prior to deploying the Loner SMD to all of its personnel, Skedaddle utilized an email check-in system, requiring its employees to check in prior to heading to an appointment, after arriving at the appointment, before climbing up on the roof, and after climbing down from the roof.

Emails were received and monitored by their customer service team that would manage emergency response and dispatch in the event that a check-in was missed. While safety compliant, Skedaddle executives and safety managers were determined to find a more effective solution. "We needed something that was more effective than the manual check-in process…" says Bill. "Our employees were losing time and we didn't feel like it was a robust enough way to mitigate the risks of workplace injury."

Following a demonstration of the Loner SMD, the executives of Skedaddle were impressed and immediately decided to begin deployment.

Worn on the belt, Loner SMD uses an always connected cellular data connection to transmit safety and location data instantly to a manager or monitoring personnel in the event of an emergency.

Because Skedaddle's employees sometimes need to provide emergency services within very large areas, the ability to locate the nearest employee to an emergency call was crucial. Loner SMD provides highly precise location data in addition to safety information to monitoring and dispatch personnel, allowing them to locate the nearest employee to route to the wildlife emergency.


